

Download Listening Activities First Grade

Here are some listening activities that you can use in your first grade classroom: 1. Group the students in pairs. For each pair, assign who will play the "blind artist" and the "smooth talker.". The artists should be blindfolded while the teacher shows a picture to the talkers. Listening skills are an important aspect of appropriate classroom behavior -- although at the kindergarten and first-grade levels, such skills can be a bit tricky to master.
